



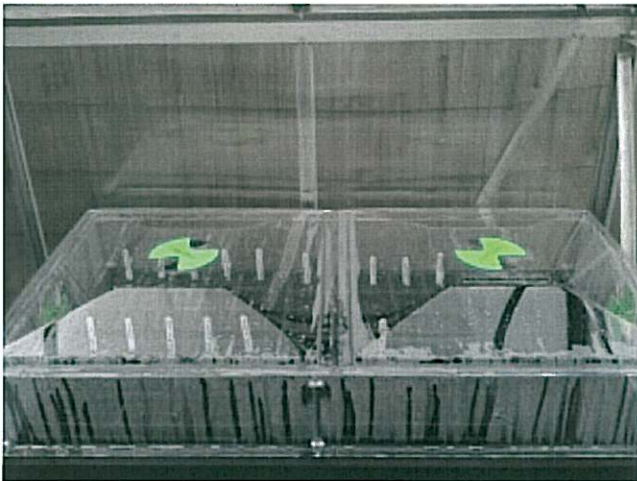

A bit of propagation for the greenhouse

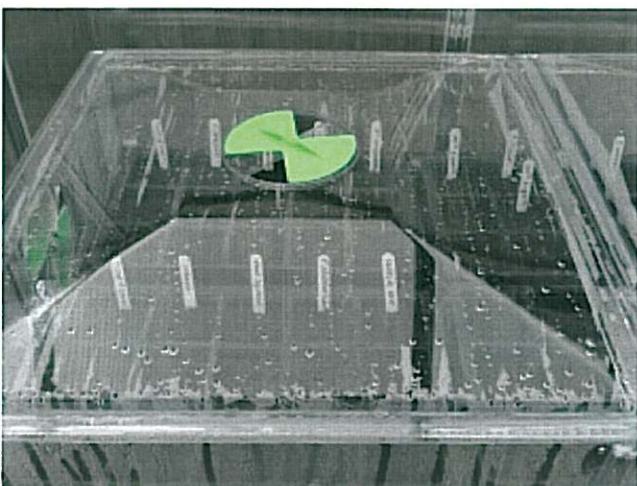

Ok so I wanted to get my crop started off nice and early. Now it's quite cold outside at this time of year and we haven't had the last frost yet, so we can expect that in early May, so a heated propagator was the only way to go.

The best one you can buy is the Vitopod from Greenhouse Sensation, its one of the most accurate and best looking. It allows you to set the temperature with an accuracy of 0.1 degrees. Here is a look at mine, I'll add some more images of the control unit and sensor.
