



The green Duogrow SmartReservoir has a transparent film covering to prevent scratches in transit. Remove this film to reveal the glossy finish.

Compost information

Choose a standard multi-purpose compost, not a water-retaining/moisture-control or heavily fertilised one.

- Place your SmartReservoir on an even surface.
- Place the Feeder Tray on top of the SmartReservoir.
- Wet one of the FeederMats.
- Insert the FeederMat through the hole into the bottom of one of the pots until the pointed tip is just below the top of the pot.
- Insert the FeederMat through the hole in the Feeder Tray and sit the pot in position. Ensure the FeederMat is touching the bottom of the reservoir.
- Repeat this with the second pot.
- Fill the pots with compost while taking care to keep the FeederMat upright.
- Firm the compost down around the FeederMat ensuring there is good contact between the FeederMat and the compost.
- Make a hole in the compost large enough for your plant. Add your plant and more compost to cover the FeederMat. Firm the compost down gently around the plant to settle the compost.
- Water well using a watering can with a rose until the compost is moist but not saturated.

Feeding and watering

Watering - The reservoir holds 25 litres of water.

- The first watering - After planting do NOT add water to the SmartReservoir until the compost is dry to the touch, this may be 2-3 days in summer, or 10-14 days in winter.
- Once the compost is dry to the touch fill the SmartReservoir with water.
- Ongoing watering - Keep the SmartReservoir topped up for best results.
- Don't panic! The top of the compost will be dry, this is normal and it prevents water from evaporating and nutrients from becoming concentrated in the compost. The compost will be moist in the root area, which is where the water is needed.

Remember: For best results always keep the SmartReservoir topped-up

Tip: Very occasionally during hot weather dampen your compost from the top.

Feeding

- Most compost has sufficient nutrients to sustain the plants for 4 weeks – check your compost label to confirm. After this time you will need to add a fertiliser/feed to the SmartReservoir, in the same way as if you were growing in a pot or growbag.
- If you are using Greenhouse Sensation feed use the following dose rate.
- The first time you add the feed – top-up the SmartReservoir so it is almost full of water and add 150ml of A to the SmartReservoir immediately followed by 150ml of B.
- Every time you add water to your SmartReservoir – for every 1 litre of water you add to the SmartReservoir add 6ml of A and 6ml of B.

If using an alternative plant feed, add the feed to the SmartReservoir using the feed manufacturer's recommended dose rates. Do not top-water with feed.
