## Setting up

- If you have a timer, (please see additional instructions for operating the timer) unscrew the green section and screw it onto the top of the timer. The bottom end of the connector unit can be screwed to the underside of the timer.
- Click the green connector unit to your waterbutt tap (or 25L mini reservoir). Then push one end of your non-drip pipe onto the stepped end of the green connector unit.
- Place your growbags in the position that they will be used with the furthest being no more than 5m from the tap.
- Place the lengths of irrigation pipe onto your growbags, make sure the length with the C-clip is set up to water the last growbag. Use 3 pegs per growbag to hold the pipe in place.
- Connect each length of irrigation pipe using the 6mm connectors already inserted into one end of the pipe.
- Attach the non-drip pipe to the irrigation pipe using the 6mm connectors. Turn the tap of your waterbutt on and you are ready to go.

## Top Tip

Ensure that all components are tightly connected to prevent leaks during watering. Both the 5m non-drip pipe and your irrigation pipe can be cut shorter to suit your needs.

## Add-on options

Water more growbags with an add-on kit. This includes three additional lengths of irrigation pipe and all necessary connectors.
