Contents:

- 1 x Planter
- 1 x Feeder tray
- 1 x SmartReservoir
- 4 x Pots
- 1 x Dipstick
- 1 x Plug
- 8 x FeederMats
(4 x Small 4 x Large)
- 1 x Nutrients A & B

Setting Up

- Place your SmartReservoir on an even surface.
- Place the Feeder Tray on top of the SmartReservoir.
- Place the square planter in the centre of the Feeder Tray so the holes match up
- Wet the four small FeederMats.
- Insert the FeederMats through the holes in the square planter and Feeder Tray until they reach the bottom of the SmartReservoir. Fold the FeederMats so they lie flat across the base of the planter.
- Wet one of the four large FeederMats.
- Insert the FeederMat into the bottom of one of the pots until the pointed tip is just below the top of the pot.
- Insert the FeederMat through the hole in the Feeder Tray and sit the pot in position.
- Repeat with the other pots.
- Insert the rubber plug into your Feeder Tray. This is for topping up your SmartReservoir

Adding your compost

- Fill the pots with compost whilst taking care to keep the FeederMats upright.
- Firm the compost down.
- Cover the FeederMats in the square planter with compost and firm it down to ensure good contact with the FeederMats

You can grow from seed in your square planter but not in your square pots.

Growing from seeds - square planter only

- See your seed packet instructions to find out how many seeds to sow and how much compost to cover them with.
- Check the compost is damp, if not water lightly.
- If you are using lids place the lids on top of the planter and close the vents.
- Open the vent gradually to decrease humidity once the seedlings have produced two seed leaves.

Plants - planter and pots

- Make a hole in the compost large enough for your plant.
- Add your plant and firm down the compost gently around the plant to settle the compost.
- Check the compost is moist around your plants, if not dampen it.
- If you are using lids, gradually open the vents to increase ventilation as your plants grow

Feeding and watering your plants

IMPORTANT:

- Add water to your nutrient bottles as indicated on the bottles.
- Once the top of the compost is dry to the touch (a few days to a week) fill your SmartReservoir with water and nutrients using the dosage rates below.
- DO NOT mix the nutrients together. It is important to add water to the watering can and then add the 'A' nutrients to the water followed by the 'B' nutrients using the dosage rates (on the reverse).

Nutrient dosage

Compost information

Use a standard multi-purpose compost, not a water-retaining/moisture-control or heavily fertilised one. Most compost contains nutrients. Check your compost bag to identify how many weeks feed the compost contains and add nutrients as described in the table below from one week before the compost is due to run out of feed. If your compost does not contain nutrients, start adding the nutrients from week one.

Dosage rates

Add 6ml of nutrient 'A' and 6ml of nutrient 'B' to every 1 litre of water. Top up the SmartReservoir as necessary. For best results keep the SmartReservoir fully topped-up.

During hot weather dampen your compost from the top when you top-up your SmartReservoir
