

Feeding and watering your plants

Important: After planting your Windowgrow do NOT add water to the Reservoir until the compost is dry to the touch, this may be a few days for young plants in the summer, or a couple of weeks for seeds sown in the winter.

Once the compost is dry to the touch add water and nutrients to the Reservoir as per the table below. Make sure you mix the nutrients with the water before adding to the Reservoir using the watering hole.

	Good growing conditions (strongly growing plants, light, warm conditions spring and summer)	Poor growing conditions (seeds and very young plants, darker, cooler conditions, autumn and winter)
How often to top-up the Reservoir	Top-up the Reservoir only when the compost is dry to the touch	
How much water to add	Up to 5litres of water mixed with nutrients.	1litre of water mixed with nutrients.
How much nutrient to add	3ml of nutrient A and 3ml of nutrient B mixed with every 1litre of water.	3ml of nutrient A and 3ml of nutrient B mixed with 1litre of water.
*The Reservoir can hold 5litres of water.		

Tip: You can dilute your nutrients at the above rate and store in a watering can or container until needed. Example mix 30ml of A and 30ml of B with 10litres of water, store in a watering can and simply measure out 1 litre each time you need to top-up your Reservoir.

What can I grow?

Herbs, salads, microgreens and dwarf chillies all grow fabulously well in a Windowgrow.

Windowgrow Components	Quantity	
Planter	1	
Reservoir	1	
Water Level Indicator	1	
Planter Feet	5	
FeederMat	1

Assembling your Windowgrow

- Place the 5 Planter Feet into the Reservoir in the places marked. Make sure the open ends of the Planter Feet are facing down
- Wet the FeederMat.
- Feed the FeederMat through the two slots on the inside of the Planter so that the FeederMat lays flat in the Planter and the two ends hang down ready to be lowered into the Reservoir
- Place the Water Level Indicator into one of the holes at either end of the Planter, the other end will be your topping-up Hole. Make sure the Water Level Indicator is the correct way up - so that the end that indicates 'Full' is facing up towards you.
- Place the Planter on the Reservoir, keeping hold of the Water Level Indicator.
- Push the Water Level Indicator down, so that its base is sitting on the floor of the Reservoir.
- Fill the Planter with approximately 5litres of compost, level and gently firm around the FeederMat to ensure good contact. If the compost isn't damp sprinkle it with water to dampen. If you can squeeze water out of a handful of compost you've added too much water, let it dry out a little before adding your seeds or young plants.

IMPORTANT: Do not add water to your Windowgrow at this point.

Where can I grow?

Place your Windowgrow in a sunny indoor or outdoor spot.

- Facing south east to south west is best.

Special notes: If you are growing on an indoor windowsill with single glazing provide some shade on the window to avoid scorching your plants in the summer (e.g. a net curtain).

Making Up Your Nutrient Concentrate

- Your two nutrient bottles contain nutrient powders which need to be mixed with water.
- Add 250ml of warm water to each bottle.
- Shake the bottles thoroughly to ensure the powder dissolves fully.
- A and B Nutrients should always be used in equal measure.
- Store the nutrient bottles in a cool dark place.

Growing from seeds

- See your seed packet instructions to find out how many seeds to sow and how much compost to cover them with.
- Follow the sowing instructions on the packet. Some seeds will need to be sown indoors in your Windowgrow.
- Check that your compost is damp, sprinkle a little water onto the compost if it isn't damp.
- Add the Lid with the vents closed.
- When the seeds have germinated you will see two small seed leaves, at this point you can remove the Lid.

IMPORTANT: Do not add water to your Windowgrow at this point.

Growing using young plants

- Make a hole in the compost large enough for your plant.
- Add your plant and firm down the compost gently.
- Check that the compost is moist around your young plants, if not dampen it.
- Add the Lid with vents open.
- Remove the Lid after two days.

IMPORTANT: Do not add water to your Windowgrow at this point.
